Dear Ashland Conservancy Home Owner,

We hope this letter finds you and your family in good spirits and good health as we enter into the Holiday Season. Along with the Holidays comes the New Year, and for your Board that means assessing how well we maintained the Community and worked within our budget. We also establish goals, look at new projects, evaluate maintenance items and decide on improvements to our Community, to determine a new budget that will allow us to achieve our goals.

As you look at the Ashland Conservancy 2023 approved budget, presented at the Annual Meeting in October, we want you to know that we are Home Owners as well, and worked hard to establish a balance between maintaining Ashland as a desirable neighborhood, bring about change, and keeping the monthly dues manageable for all.

This year we have seen a rise in the number of functioning committees, which in turn have taken an active role in presenting their budget requests to the Board. This action is welcomed by the Board and will help the committees to plan events, purchase pool furniture, welcome new owners, and make improvements in the community. As always, the committees are comprised of volunteers and can always use new members.

We don't need to remind you that over the last few years we have all felt a price increase in everything we buy and consume, inflation is ~9% right now, and markets are uncertain. Just like your home budget, we too have felt the increases in our goods that we procure and more importantly the services we contract for. The increase in price for goods that our vendors have to pay are passed on to us. The last time Ashland monthly dues were raised was 4 years ago. The Board felt that we needed to raise dues for CY2023 in order to continue our improvements and be able to increase the money we place into Reserves, so our homes maintain their value and Ashland continues to be a well-maintained community.

The new monthly rates for CY2023 are; Single Family Homes \$ 91.00, Townhomes \$106.00. We feel that this increase is warranted and will allow us to move forward as a Community.

Only homeowners are allowed to sign for a key fob. The first key fob is issued free of charge, you can purchase extra keys for a \$10 fee.

Residents must be 18yrs. old to use the fitness room. Minors 15yrs. to 17yrs. can use the fitness room without an adult as long as the parent/legal guardian has signed a waiver and purchased a key fob. Minors 13yrs. to 14 yrs.must be accompanied by an adult.

Please remember children under the age of 13 yrs. are not permitted in the fitness facility. Guests are not allowed to use the fitness facility.

For your convenience you may pick up the key fob after business hours at the Fitness Center


Residents have inquired about the appropriate color to repaint the fading and chipping mailbox posts.

The following is a schedule of your pickup days

Trash - TUESDAY/FRIDAY Yard Debris - TUESDAY Recycling - FRIDAY Bulk Items - FRIDAY

TRASH PICKUP - Household waste only, no construction or remodeling waste. No Household Hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas, antifreeze, corrosive chemicals, etc.). For more information on Household Hazardous Waste contact the Prince William County Office of Solid Waste @ 703-792-6254.

YARD DEBRIS - Grass clippings & leaves should be bagged in brown paper bags, these compostable paper bags can be purchased online, you can buy them at the grocery store, or find them at warehouse stores such as Home Depot, Lowes or any garden center. We will not collect yard debris material in plastic bags. Personal cans may be used, however they need to be clearly marked *Yard Debris* Tree limbs and brush must be no longer than 4-5 feet in length and 3 inches thick in diameter. These items must be tied with rope or twine in arm length bundles. Items that are bagged or bundled are not to exceed 50 lbs. Rocks, bricks, sod and dirt are not acceptable. We will collect up to 10 bags and/or labeled personal cans and up to 10 bundles of brush per collection.

Yard waste season ends effective December 24th, and will resume March 1st, 2023

RECYCLING PICKUP - Acceptable items include: Aluminum cans, aluminum foil & trays rinsed & cleaned, metal food & beverage cans, #1 thru #7 plastics, plastic bottles, wide mouth plastic containers & rigid plastics. Newspapers, mixed paper, junk mail, magazines, phone books & catalogs. Empty aerosol cans. Cardboard, paperboard (including cereal boxes without the lining and frozen food packages, etc) and corrugated cardboard. Moving boxes are recyclable & must be placed out with recycling collection. *These items may be commingled in the same recycling container. We prefer you do not use plastic bags for recycling.

BULK ITEMS - Please notify customer service @ 703-368-0500 at least 24 hours in advance when putting out bulk items.

HOLIDAYS – American Disposal Services does not operate on Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year's days. Your trash &/or recycling will be picked up on the next scheduled collection day.

Please have your waste & recycling @ curbside by 5:00 AM or the night before.
